1. When is the first day of school?

Wednesday Dismissal for all students in Grades PK – 5, 1:50 p.m.

o Grades 6 - 12: 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

3. Will there be an MSO (Virtual) option available at iPrep Academy for the 2021-2022 school year?

No. All students attending iPrep Academy will be attending school physically.

5. Will my child have to withdraw from iPrep Academy to enroll for either Miami-Dade Online or Miami-Dade Virtual School?

6. Can I reapply for my child to attend iPrep Academy when I'm ready to have my child return physically?

Yes, you can reapply for the Magnet Lottery at <http://yourchoicemiami.org> from October 1st – January 15th for the 2022-2023 school year. You will be informed in March of 2022 whether your child was ACCEPTED or WAITLISTED for the 2022-2023 school year. Re-enrollment is not guaranteed as your child will be entered into a random lottery drawing.

7. Will the school have a MANDATORY mask policy?

As per the State of Florida Office of the Governor Executive Order Number 21-175 (Ensuring Parents' Freedom to Choose – Masks in Schools) signed on July 30, 2021, masks for children in school will be optional. Miami-Dade County Public Schools will meet and consult with local health officials in the coming days

regarding the school experience in the fall, particularly as it relates to the mask policy in schools and District facilities.
