This year, we'll be using Khan Academy for our summer math assignments to personalize preparation for all students.

Khan Academy is a free online resource that allows students to learn anytime, anywhere, with material that is uniquely appropriate for them. Students can explore new topics and strengthen their skills by doing practice problems and tutorials. As students learn, their activity feeds into reports that show important information such as strengths and weaknesses in a particular concept. By using Khan Academy, we'll be able to provide a more personalized learning experience for your child.

Students are asked to visit <http://www.khanacademy.org/join> and enter their class code:

Rising 7th Graders: **HAB6BXZJ**

Rising 8th Graders: **RK7K7PBH**

Students will be marked as having completed the course once they achieve 90% or higher mastery and completed the notes packet found in Teams. Rising 7th Graders must also complete the assigned Khan Academy activities with a score of 75% or higher.

1. Log-in to Khan Academy with your child using the account information given in class
2. Click on their Username → Settings in the upper right corner.
3. Enter your email address in the "New email" field under "Parent/Guardian email"
4. Check your inbox for an email from Khan Academy
5. Follow the sign-in or log-in prompts to get started.

As a parent, you'll be able to see what your child is working on. You will also can edit your child's username and password.
