








PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Curriculum: Scholastic Big Day & International Education/Extended Foreign Language

- In Big Day for PK, each day is organized around three Big Experiences: Whole Group, Circle Time, and Story Time lessons

Transcripts

- Current MDCPS student-need not upload transcripts
- Non-MDCPS must upload transcripts and attendance record for entire previous school year and first grading period of current year. Cannot submit application without uploading.

Students must have taken Physical Science Honors & Algebra 1 Honors and passed EOC in 8th grade to be eligible for 9th Grade

- ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED THROUGH PARENT PORTAL ON DADESCHOOLS.NET

- CHOOSE UP TO 5 SCHOOLS
- PRIORITY
 - MILITARY OR VETERAN (MUST UPLOAD PAPERWORK)
 - SIBLINGS (APPLYING & CURRENTLY ATTENDING)
 - DISTRICT EMPLOYEES (5% OF AVAILABLE SEATS IN THAT GRADE LEVEL)
 - PRIORITY IS NOT 100%-CONTINGENT ON NUMBER OF SEATS AVAILABLE
- RANDOM LOTTERY SELECTION
- PARENTS WILL BE NOTIFIED ON MARCH 15, 2024 AND NOTIFICATION WILL BE SENT OUT BY THE SYSTEM- NOT THE SCHOOL
- EITHER OFFERED A SEAT OR PLACED ON WAITLIST
- IF OFFERED A SEAT, PARENT WILL HAVE 2 WEEKS FROM 3/15 TO ACCEPT THE SEAT IN THE SYSTEM OR SEAT WILL BE FORFEITED.
- AFTER THE 2 WEEK PERIOD, THE SYSTEM WILL SELECT STUDENTS ON THE WAITLIST AND OFFER SEATS AVAILABLE.
